Dear Parent/Carer,

New Build update and advanced notice of school closures

The builders have confirmed that the new building will be ready during August which means that we will be able to move in at the start of the new school year in September.

As you will probably understand, moving out of the old building and into the new and ensuring that the new building is ready for the children is going to be a massive task. For this reason we will be closing the school for the last 2 days of term 6 - **Monday 23rd July 2018 and Tuesday 24th July 2018** - which means the school year will end on **Friday 20th July 2018**.

This will allow us to pack and label everything that is moving over.

So that we can then unpack and set up the new building we will delay opening the new school until **Thursday 6th September 2018**. This means that the school will be closed to children on **Monday 3rd September 2018, Tuesday 4th September 2018 and Wednesday 5th September 2018**.

I understand that this may be inconvenient for some families but I hope you will appreciate the scale of the task and bear with us whilst we relocate.

We are planning to have an official opening of the new building by the Mayor of Bristol, Marvin Rees, on Tuesday 4th September at 3pm. I will be inviting any children and families and local residents to view the building on that afternoon and will send out more details before the summer holidays.
