Sports Premium Provision Map 2018 – 19

The PE and Sports Premium is designed to help schools improve the quality of the PE and sport activities they offer their pupils.

The funding for Minerva Primary Academy in 2018/19 is £18,270

After School Sports Clubs

Overview: After school sports clubs are provided every day of the week and are funded by the PE and Sports Premium. These are run by our sports LSA.

Cost: £9,500

Aim/Outcome: To enable all pupils to participate in after school sport activities

Sports Day -Cost: £500

Aim/Outcome: For all pupils to experience structured activities. To get involved, stay active and gain confidence in their sporting abilities

IMPACT: Clubs run have included football, dodgeball, netball, basketball, gymnastics, cricket, play active, fitness, athletics, BMX. Clubs attended by 57%children over the year. Sports day included <u>all</u> children in KS1 and KS2. Y6 children led KS1 Sport's Day. Pupil voice indicated 100% enjoyed clubs and increased sporting confidence as a result. 2% of pupils went on to other sporting clubs (outside school BMX).

NEXT STEPS: Pupil Voice to determine new clubs for next year. Investigate other sports opportunities (rock wall climbing, cheerleading)

Additional Weekly Sports Session offsite (swimming - Y6)

Overview: To promote healthy living to all pupils

Cost: £1026

Aim/Outcome: To give all pupils opportunity to participate in various sports.

Top up swimming for Y6 Terms 5 and 6.

93% did not meet all 3 requirements in first assessment. (7% could)

38% met all 3 requirements at the end of sessions.

NEXT STEPS: Make links with leisure centre to entice more children to swim in their leisure time and are able to meet Y6 requirements.

Professional Development

Overview: To provide opportunities for class teachers to have training in REAL PE scheme and to work alongside sports LSA

Cost: £3000 (20% Sports LSA)

Aim/Outcome: For teachers to gain greater confidence, experience and PE teaching skills that they can apply to future lessons

Teachers received training September 2018

REAL PE used in all PE lessons with sports LSA assisting

98% teachers enjoying teaching PE and report increased participation by all (children monitoring and evaluating if not able to participate) (Teacher voice) 2% of teachers would like more support in planning and implementing. Teachers would like split PE sessions (1 class instead of 2)

NEXT STEPS: Train new staff and CH to work alongside teachers. JH to revise PE timetable Renew subscription/Further develop CH with REAL PE training

Additional Weekly Sports Session (SEN)

Overview: To promote healthy living to all pupils

Cost: £1026

Aim/Outcome: To give SEND children OT and Physio sessions with LSA.

4 children given extra PE, physio and OT sessions. Progress measured by NR during lessons then externally assessed. All children made good progress in Fundamentals through extra sessions.

NEXT STEPS: Identify children in new academic year who will receive extra sessions

CLF Festival of Games

Overview: CLF support of sports coach CLF Festival of Games Transport for Competitions

Cost: £2,300 including transport

Aim/Outcome: Opportunities for pupils to take part in organised sports competitions with other schools

9 competitions attended over the year, PP children made up 17% of this number.
Basketball team made it to finals, raised profile of sport and competition. (Pupil voice)
New kit funded by PTFA. Children gained more confidence in playing competitively
(pupil voice) Bronze award achieved in School Sports Games
NEXT STEPS: Increase/maintain participation. Aim for SILVER in SSGs.

Sports and PE equipment

Overview: To ensure all children have access to a variety of different equipment

£850

Aim/outcome: To provide long lasting opportunities for pupils to experience a wider range of sporting activities. To develop independence in using a range of equipment.

Equipment now stored in new PE cupboard, sorted and labelled.
Netball posts ordered. £210
Sports Day equipment purchased ££25
NEXT STEPS: Audit PE equipment and assess quality.

Sports Apprentice

Overview: To employ apprentice to work with all pupils

Cost: £1,084

Aim/Outcome: To provide a sports coach for all pupils

To promote positive role models and develop the link between PE/Sport and Learning

To increase participation in break and lunchtime physical activity

Sports Apprentices on volunteer basis in Term 1 and 2. NR in the playground every playtime and lunchtime to provide organised sports inclusive of all, including Woman's Wednesdays.

NEXT STEPS: Introduce play leaders so that children can become leaders and run activity sessions.
