Learning Enquiry: History focus
We will be learning:

Pupils will be taught about the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor. This includes:

- a) Viking raids and invasion
- b) resistance by Alfred the Great and Athelstan, first king of England
- c) further Viking invasions and Danegeld
- d) Anglo-Saxon laws and justice
- e) Edward the Confessor and his death in 1066

Numeracy

We will be learning to:

- Recall our times table and division facts up to 12 X 12
- Read and write decimals as fractions
- Write percentages as a fraction with the denominator of 100 and a decimal
- Solve problems where the fraction or decimal answer has to be rounded
- Solve problems involving relative quantities (ratio) using multiplication and division
- Solve problems involving similar shapes where the scale factor is known
- Solve unequal sharing or grouping (proportion) problems
- Solve problems involving comparison and calculation of
